

## **Report on feedback of students about curriculum**

The feedback of students regarding the curriculum was taken in each session from 2021-2022 once in the academic year. The curriculum has changed from 2020 and the university has adopted a semester system. The feedback is collected from each student and analysed statistically.

### **2021-22**

- 1) Almost 54% students felt that the syllabus was good in inculcating learning values in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge and analytical abilities and the course was appropriate in terms of depth, coverage and extent of effort required by the students while 40% said that the syllabus was very good.
- 2) About 68% felt that the syllabus was adequate and benefit from course was relevant
- 3) Around 71.4% said that 90-100% syllabus was taught in the class and 53% said that extent of course taught was 75-100%
- 4) Around 71% students said that the library had adequate books for their course and they were getting a good amount of books
- 5) About the internal evaluation system 69% students said that it was good and about 75% of the course was covered in it
- 6) The feedback of the students regarding the internal assessment being conducive to understanding the course, early discovery of difficulties, interaction with teachers, regular work and continuous assessment ranged from appreciable to moderate.
- 7) Around 57% students said that they sometimes participated in the extracurricular activities.
- 8) Thus around 71% students have rated the overall programme curriculum as good

## **Report on feedback of parents about curriculum**

### **2021-22**

1. About 99% parents found the syllabus relevant and the course beneficial for the students
2. According to 70% parents 90 to 100% syllabus was taught in the class
3. About 98% parents were satisfied with the internal evaluation system and they said that the total weightage of the course in internal evaluation system should be about 78%

4. The overall rating of programme curriculum in terms of academic content, fairness of evaluation and usefulness in current scenario was good
5. About 85% parents reported an upgradation of hard and soft skills

### **Report on feedback of teachers about curriculum**

The feedback of teachers regarding the curriculum was taken in each session from 2021-2022 once in the academic year. The feedback is collected from each teacher and analysed statistically.

#### **2021-22**

- 9) Almost 100% teachers felt that syllabus is suitable for course and is need based, the aims and objectives are well defined and clear to teachers and students. The course content has corresponding reference materials and sufficient books are available in the library
- 10) 56% teachers felt that they have freedom to suggest and incorporate new topics in syllabus
- 11) 80% felt that they can use new techniques for teaching
- 12) Only 28.6% felt that university provides support for research and projects.

### **Report on feedback of parents about institute**

Such a type of feedback has greatly helped the institute to overcome its short comings. The feedback is collected from each parent and analysed statistically.

#### **2021-22**

- 1) About 35% parents have rated the institute to be a teaching oriented institute while 45% were happy about the campus.
- 2) About 55% parents said that they have taken a to the college since they found it to be a good academic institute
- 3) 42.9% parents have experienced that the laboratories have been upgraded and infrastructure development has been done
- 4) 93% parents have found the teaching learning process satisfactory.
- 5) 70% parents have rated the teacher student relationship as very good and nearly 91% parents have got their expectations fulfilled.

### **Report on feedback of Alumni about institute**
